

The Angus Local Government Area (Electoral Arrangements) Direction 1994

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by paragraph 1(1) of Schedule 2 to the Local Government etc. (Scotland) Act 1994(a) and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and after carrying out such consultation as he considers appropriate, hereby makes the following Direction:

Citation and commencement

1. This Direction may be cited as the Angus Local Government Area (Electoral Arrangements) Direction 1994 and shall come into force on 11th November 1994.

Interpretation

2. In this Direction—

“electoral division” means a division of Tayside Region as constituted by the Tayside Region (Electoral Arrangements) Order 1993(b);

“polling district” means a polling district for Tayside Regional Council elections as at 1st December 1993;



"Dundee Report" means the report of the Local Government Boundary Commission for Scotland to the Secretary of State for Scotland on its second statutory review of electoral arrangements for the City of Dundee District dated 9th February 1994.

Specification of Wards

3. For the purpose of any election of councillors held before the relevant year of election, the Angus local government area shall be divided into 26 electoral wards being-

- (a) the twenty two proposed wards described in the Angus Report; and
- (b) the four electoral wards having the names, numbers and boundaries set out in the Schedule to this Direction.

ANGUS ELECTORAL WARDS 23 TO 26

Electoral Ward 23: Sidlaw West

Polling district PDD and those parts of polling districts ADA and PDC in the Angus local government area lying within electoral division 31 (Sidlaw).

Electoral Ward 24: Sidlaw East

Polling districts ADB and ADD and those parts of polling districts ADC, ADE, ADF, ADG and WEC in the Angus local government area lying within electoral division 31 (Sidlaw).

Electoral Ward 25: Monifieth West

That area described in the Dundee Report as "District Ward 37: Monifieth West".

Electoral Ward 26: Monifieth East

That area described in the Dundee Report as "District Ward 38: Monifieth East".
