

**Second Review of Scottish Parliament Boundaries
Further Proposals or Final Recommendations - Constituency Names and
designations**

Action required

1. The Commission is invited to agree: -
 - (i) the names and designation for constituencies, within its constituency grouping of Argyll and Bute, East Dunbartonshire, Falkirk, North Lanarkshire, South Lanarkshire, West Dunbartonshire and West Lothian Council areas.
 - (ii) the designation for all other constituencies.

Background

2. The Commission agreed constituency names for all areas at its meeting of 23 July 2024, except those subject to the Falkirk local inquiry held on 22 August 2024, see Appendix A.
3. The Assistant Commissioner's Report, transcript from the Falkirk local inquiry and maps of alternative constituency boundaries are available in Paper 126 - Second Review - Argyll and Bute, East Dunbartonshire, Falkirk, North Lanarkshire, South Lanarkshire, West Dunbartonshire and West Lothian Council areas.
4. The Assistant Commissioner also highlighted in her report that the proposed names of the new constituencies (Falkirk North; Linlithgow and Falkirk South; Cumbernauld and Kilsyth) are not representative and cause confusion.
5. During the consultation on Revised Proposals for constituencies the Commission consulted on 17 constituencies within the Argyll and Bute, East Dunbartonshire, Falkirk, North Lanarkshire, South Lanarkshire, West Dunbartonshire and West Lothian Council areas.
6. Of those 17 constituencies, 12 constituency boundaries were unchanged or had minor changes to their boundaries. These included: Argyll and Bute; Airdrie; Clydebank and Milngavie; Clydesdale; Coatbridge and Chryston; Dumbarton; East Kilbride; Hamilton, Larkhall and Stonehouse; Motherwell and Wishaw; Rutherglen; Strathkelvin and Bearsden; and Uddingston and Bellshill. The existing Airdrie and Shotts constituency was renamed Airdrie to differentiate it from the UK Parliament constituency with the same name.
7. The remaining constituencies were renamed: Bathgate; Falkirk North; Linlithgow and Falkirk South; and Livingston and Breich Valley. Although its boundary was amended the Commission retained a constituency named Cumbernauld and Kilsyth.
8. A map of this area is shown in Appendix B.

Suggestions

9. During the consultation on its Revised Proposals and at the local inquiry there were comments and suggestions on the proposed constituency names. These included:
 - opposition to the proposed: Falkirk North; and Linlithgow and Falkirk South constituency names because there are wards named Falkirk North and Falkirk South and it will cause confusion having two similar electoral boundaries with the same name. The existing Falkirk constituencies are

named Falkirk East and Falkirk West. The suggestions for the Falkirk constituencies included:

- Falkirk West and Linlithgow
 - Falkirk East
 - Linlithgow and Falkirk East
 - Falkirk South and Linlithgow.
- Including Denny or Denny and Banknock in the proposed Cumbernauld and Kilsyth constituency name. Other suggestions were: Cumbernauld, Denny and Kilsyth; Denny, Kilsyth and Cumbernauld; and Cumbernauld, Kilsyth and Denny. According to the NRS settlements and localities estimated population at mid-2020 data, the population of: Cumbernauld is 50,530; Kilsyth is 10,380; Denny is 8,500; Banknock is 2,400; and Hags/ Longcroft is 990.
 - A number of responses opposed the proposed Airdrie constituency name and wish to retain the existing name - Airdrie and Shotts. One comment suggested Airdrie and Auchter Water as a constituency name. The source of Auchter Water is the Gladsmuir Hills which lie between Shotts and Carluke/ Forth. It flows into South Calder Water and then the Clyde. According to NRS, Shotts has a population of 8,600 and Airdrie 36,400. The electoral ward Fortissat includes Shotts and the area in the constituency south of the M8. Fortissat appears on maps to the north of Steps, and consists of small hamlets.
 - In West Lothian there were suggestions to rename the proposed: Linlithgow and Falkirk South constituency as Linlithgow and Falkirk East; and the Bathgate constituency as West Lothian North or West Lothian Central. One reason for this was there is a ward named Bathgate.
 - In South Lanarkshire there were suggestions to rename the proposed Rutherglen constituency as: Rutherglen and Cambuslang; or Rutherglen, Cambuslang and Blantyre. The three main localities within the constituency are Rutherglen, Cambuslang and Blantyre. According to NRS their populations are: 30,950 – Rutherglen; 30,790 – Cambuslang; and 16,800 – Blantyre. The existing Rutherglen constituency boundary is unchanged.

Naming policies

10. The Commission's Second Review Guidance Booklet includes an extract from the Scotland Act 1998, Schedule 1, rule 8. It states the recommendations for each constituency must include:

- “the name by which it should be known and
- whether it should be designated as a county constituency or a burgh constituency. The designation of a constituency affects the expenses allowable at elections.”

11. The Act does not define the terms burgh constituency or county constituency but where constituencies include predominantly urban areas, they will normally be designated as burgh constituencies, and where constituencies are predominantly rural, they will normally be designated as county constituencies.

12. As discussed at the last meeting, Boundary Commission for Scotland (BCS) had guidelines for naming constituencies for its 2023 Review of UK Parliamentary Constituencies. An extract from the BCS 2023 Review Policies and Procedures booklet on naming constituencies is below for information:

“As part of a review, we recommend a name for each constituency, and have developed a set of guidelines when proposing names for constituencies:

- to use an existing constituency name where there is a successor constituency that is recognisably similar;
- to prefer constituency names that are short rather than attempt to describe an area exhaustively;
- to ensure that names of UK Parliament constituencies in general differ from those of Scottish Parliament constituencies where an appropriate and distinct alternative is available. Relying on word order alone (e.g. ‘Glasgow East’ and ‘East Glasgow’) or conjunctions (e.g. ‘North and East Fife’) is generally not a sufficient difference;
- not to place compass points at the beginning of a name, in order to help make an alphabetically sorted list easier to use. We make an exception if a constituency is named after a council area or town which has a compass point at the start of its name (such as East Lothian or East Kilbride); and
- to use ‘South West’ rather than ‘Southwest.’

We take account of local views when recommending names for constituencies, and also encourage local authorities to submit suggestions to us.

We are required to designate each constituency as either a burgh or a county constituency, but the 1986 Act does not define these terms. We consider that constituencies comprising predominantly urban areas will normally be designated as burgh constituencies, and constituencies which are predominantly rural will normally be designated as county constituencies. The designation affects the expenses allowable at elections. For this review, our proposed constituencies smaller than 109 km² are typically classified as burgh constituencies.”

13. Boundaries Scotland is not bound by this guidance but may wish to take these factors into account when deciding names.

Historical names

14. The Boundary Commission for Scotland’s (BCS) Information Paper “Constituency names in Scotland since 1950” includes the names of both UK and Scottish Parliament constituencies. It includes all constituency names from 1950 onwards. A printed copy is enclosed or [an online version is available](#).

15. The Boundary Commission for Scotland has a web-map with current and historical UK Parliament constituencies from 1950, www.bcomm-scotland.independent.gov.uk/?q=boundary-maps/constituency-maps. Boundaries Scotland has a web-map with current and previous Scottish Parliament constituencies since 1999 <https://boundaries.scot/scottish-parliament-boundary-maps-1999-2011>.

Settlement populations

16. The National Records of Scotland (NRS) Population Estimates for Settlements and Localities in Scotland, mid-2020, provides a list of the estimated population of

settlements in Scotland. The top 300 most populated localities have been printed (Appendix C) and can also be viewed on the NRS website www.nrscotland.gov.uk/statistics-and-data/statistics/statistics-by-theme/population/population-estimates/settlements-and-localities/mid-2020. They are also available on an online map <https://scotland.shinyapps.io/nrs-settlements-localities-map/>.

Ward names

17. During the consultation on its Revised Proposals some comments stated the proposed constituency names were confusing because they were the same as ward names. This was also raised as a concern at the Falkirk Local Inquiry. A list of all ward names has been printed for reference (Appendix D). These are also available on the National Records of Scotland (NRS) website: www.nrscotland.gov.uk/files//statistics/people-reg-vote/1-dec-23/people-registered-to-vote-23-data.xlsx - see table 5 tab.

Designations

18. Whilst legislation does not define the size of a Burgh or County constituency, Burgh constituencies are generally urban and County constituencies are more rural.
19. All of the existing burgh constituencies cover an area of 106 km² or less with one exception: Airdrie and Shotts burgh constituency (214 km²). All of the existing county constituencies cover an area of 109 km² or more with three exceptions: Clydebank and Milngavie county constituency (71 km²); Kirkcaldy county constituency (100 km²); Cumbernauld and Kilsyth county constituency (105 km²).
20. For the Provisional Proposals consultation all burgh constituencies covered an area of 68 km² or less. All county constituencies covered an area of 89 km² or more.
21. For the Revised Proposals consultation all burgh constituencies covered an area of 105 km² or less. All county constituencies covered an area of 124 km² or more.
22. During the provisional and revised consultations, no responses raised concerns with the proposed constituency designations.
23. Appendix B includes a list of the constituency names (Further Proposals or Final Recommendations) agreed at the Commissions 23 July 2024 meeting, their area and proposed designation. It proposes all burgh constituencies are less than 105 km² and all county constituencies covered an area of 125 km² or more. The Commission has still to agree its Further Proposals for a Falkirk North constituency at 125 km² and this constituencies area may change.

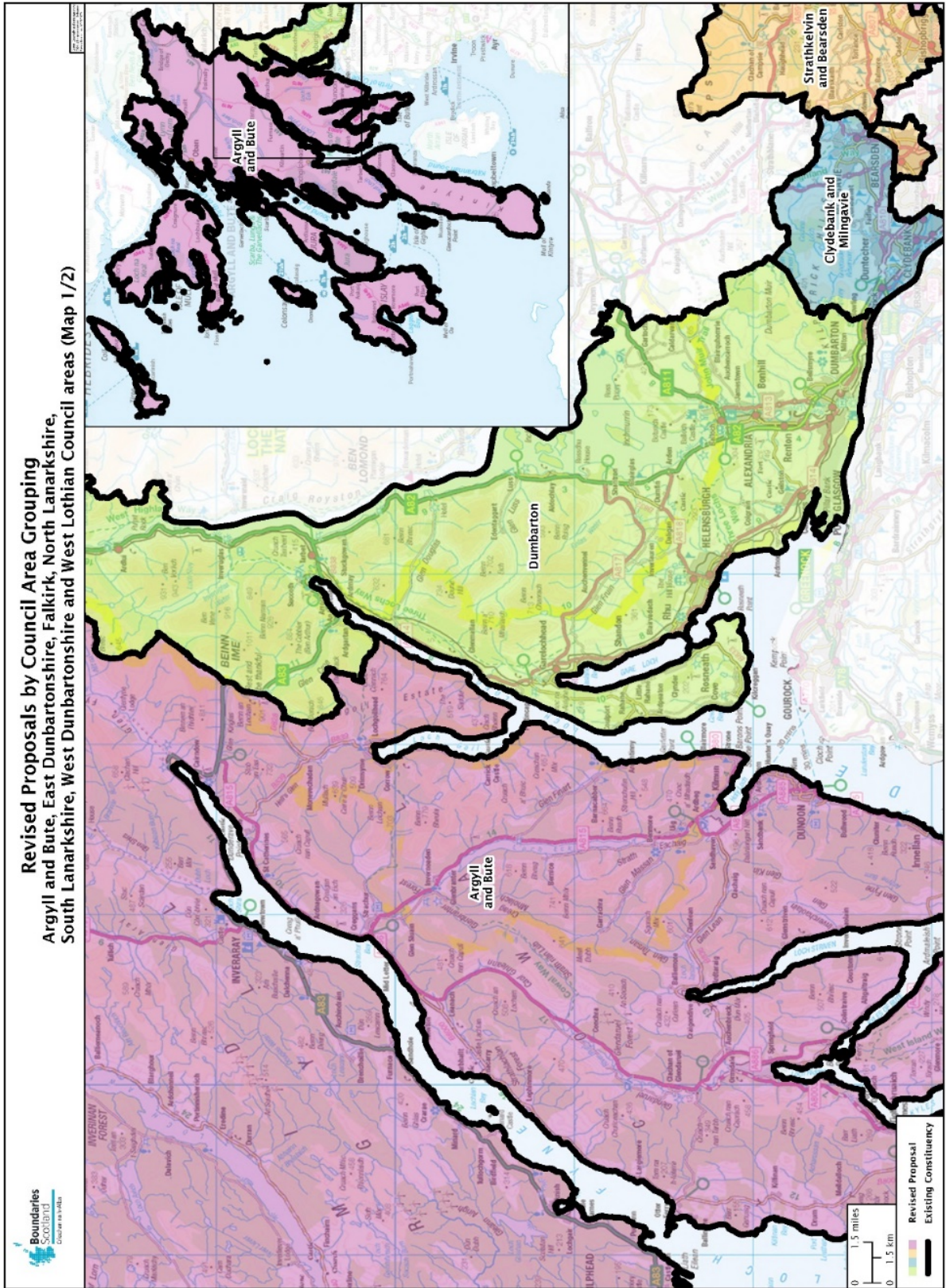
Recommendation

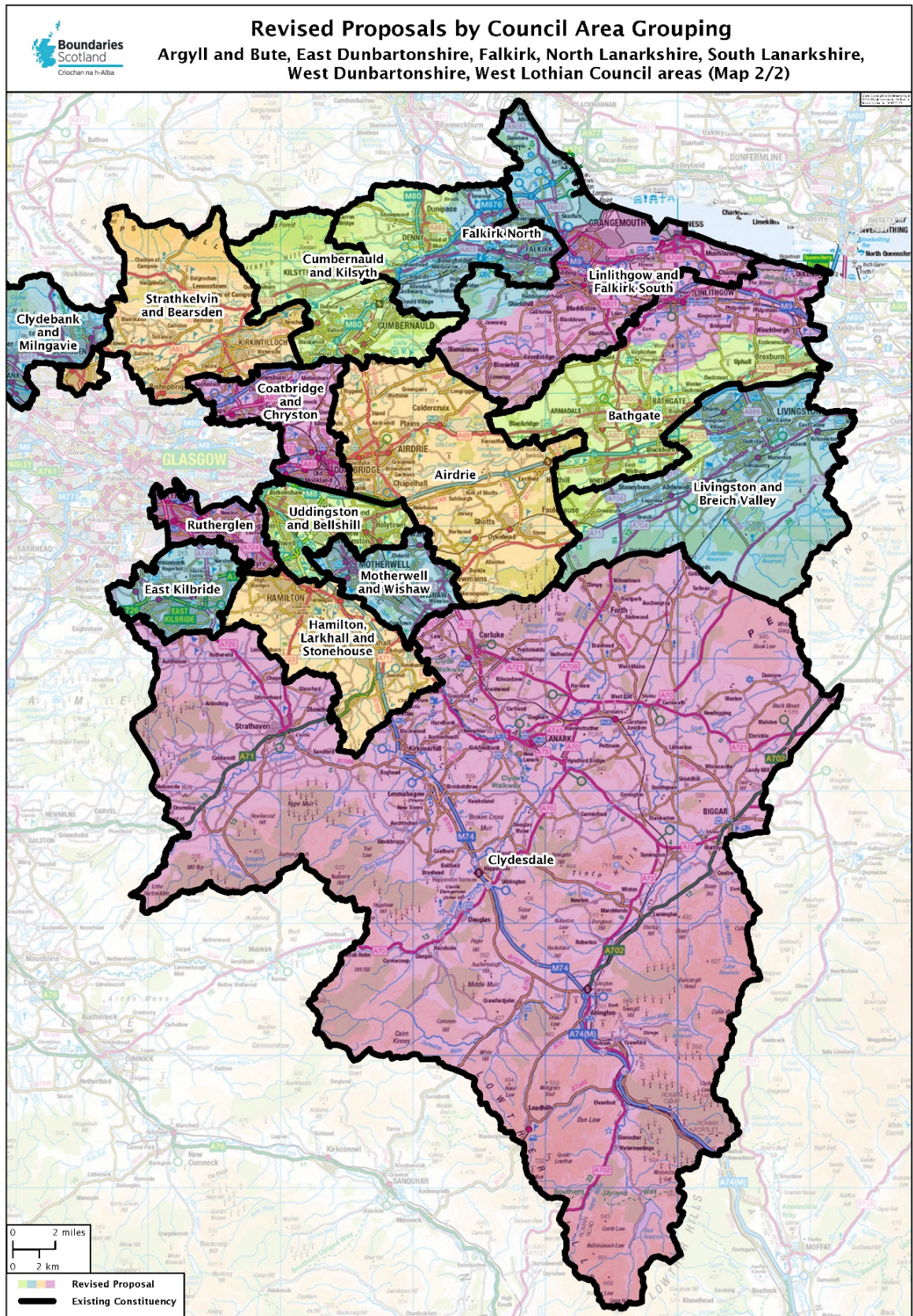
24. The Secretariat recommends that the Commission agree its further proposals for and final recommendations for constituency names and designations.
