

# The City of Dundee Local Government Area (Electoral Arrangements) Direction 1994

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by paragraph 1(1) of Schedule 2 to the Local Government etc. (Scotland) Act 1994(a) and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and after carrying out such consultation as he considers appropriate, hereby makes the following Direction:

## Citation and commencement

1. This Direction may be cited as the City of Dundee Local Government Area (Electoral Arrangements) Direction 1994 and shall come into force on 11th November 1994.

## Interpretation

- 2.— (1) In this Direction—

“polling district” means a polling district for Tayside Regional Council elections as at 1st December 1993;

“Report” means the report of the Local Government Boundary Commission for Scotland to the Secretary of State for Scotland on its second statutory review of electoral arrangements for the City of Dundee District dated 9th February 1994(b) (subject to the amendments set out at sub-paragraph (2) below).

(2) For the purposes of this Direction, the description of wards referred to in the Report as published is amended as follows:—

- (a) in District Ward 5 (Lochee East) for the words “Road, Logie”, substitute the words “Road and Logie”; and
- (b) in District Ward 30 (Whitfield South) for the words “on Electoral”, substitute the words “of Electoral”.

### Specification of Wards

3. For the purpose of any election of councillors held before the relevant year of election, the City of Dundee local government area shall be divided into 36 electoral wards being the proposed wards numbered District Ward 1 (Dudhope) to District Ward 36 (Dalhousie) described in the Report, subject to the modifications in respect of electoral wards 13 (Menziesshill West), 16 (Pitalpin), 17 (Ardler), 19 (St Mary’s West), 20 (Downfield), 27 (Fintry North), 29 (Whitfield North), 35 (Balgillo) and 36 (Dalhousie) specified in the Schedule to this Direction.

**MODIFICATIONS IN RESPECT OF ELECTORAL WARDS**

1. Electoral Ward 13 (Menziesshill West) shall comprise District Ward 13 (Menziesshill West) together with those parts of polling districts PDA and PDC lying within the City of Dundee local government area.
2. Electoral Ward 16 (Pitalpin) shall comprise District Ward 16 (Pitalpin) together with that part of polling district WEG lying within the City of Dundee local government area.
3. Electoral Ward 17 (Ardler) shall comprise District Ward 17 (Ardler) together with those parts of polling districts WEF and ADA lying within the City of Dundee local government area.
4. Electoral Ward 19 (St Mary's West) shall comprise District Ward 19 (St Mary's West) together with those parts of polling districts WEE and ADC lying within the City of Dundee local government area.
5. Electoral Ward 20 (Downfield) shall comprise District Ward 20 (Downfield) together with that part of polling district WED lying within the City of Dundee local government area.
6. Electoral Ward 27 (Fintry North) shall comprise District Ward 27 (Fintry North) together with that part of polling district ADE lying within the City of Dundee local government area.
7. Electoral Ward 29 (Whitfield North) shall comprise District Ward 29 (Whitfield North) together with that part of polling district ADF lying within the City of Dundee local government area.

8. Electoral Ward 35 (Balgillo) shall comprise District Ward 35 (Balgillo) together with that part of polling district EDN lying within the City of Dundee local government area.

9. Electoral Ward 36 (Dalhousie) shall comprise District Ward 36 (Dalhousie) together with that part of polling district EDQ lying within the City of Dundee local government area.
