

The East Dunbartonshire Local Government Area (Electoral Arrangements) Direction 1994

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by paragraph 1(1) of Schedule 2 to the Local Government etc. (Scotland) Act 1994(a) and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and after carrying out such consultation as he considers appropriate, hereby makes the following Direction:

Citation and commencement

1. This Direction may be cited as the East Dunbartonshire Local Government Area (Electoral Arrangements) Direction 1994 and shall come into force on 11th November 1994.

Interpretation

2. In this Direction—

“district ward”, for the purpose of the description of electoral ward 26 in paragraph 3(1)(c) below, means a ward for district council elections as at 7th May 1992;

“electoral division” means a division of Strathclyde Region as constituted by the Strathclyde Region (Electoral Arrangements) Order 1993(b);

“Bearsden and Milngavie Report” means the report of the Local Government Boundary Commission for Scotland to the Secretary of State for Scotland on its second

statutory review of electoral arrangements for Bearsden and Milngavie District dated 6th June 1994(a);

“Strathkelvin Report” means the report of the Local Government Boundary Commission for Scotland to the Secretary of State for Scotland on its second statutory review of electoral arrangements for Strathkelvin District dated 27th June 1994.

Specification of Wards

3.— (1) For the purpose of any election of councillors held before the relevant year of election, the East Dunbartonshire local government area shall be divided into 26 electoral wards being—

- (a) the ten proposed wards described in the Bearsden and Milngavie Report;
- (b) the fifteen proposed wards numbered District Ward 1 (Cadder and Langbrae) to District Ward 15 (Woodhill East) described (subject to the amendments set out in sub-paragraph (2) below) in the Strathkelvin Report with those electoral wards being numbered wards 11 to 25 respectively in place of the numbering of those proposed wards in the Strathkelvin Report; and
- (c) the following electoral ward:—

Electoral Ward 26: South Lenzie/Waterside

That area comprising the South Lenzie/Waterside district ward in electoral division 46 (Chryston).

(2) For the purposes of this Direction, the description of the wards referred to in the Strathkelvin Report is amended as follows:—

(a) Copies of the reports referred to in this Direction are available from the Local Government Boundary Commission for Scotland by applying to the Secretary, New St Andrew's House, Edinburgh, EH1 3TG.

- (a) in District Ward 2 (North Kirkintilloch and Torrance), for "6914", substitute "6194";
- (b) in the name of District Ward 12, after the word "Balmuildy", insert the word "and"; and
- (c) in District Ward 14 (Woodhill West), after the word "Balmuildy", insert the word "and".
