

The Fife Local Government Area (Electoral Arrangements) Direction 1994

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by paragraph 1(1) of Schedule 2 to the Local Government etc. (Scotland) Act 1994(a) and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and after carrying out such consultation as he considers appropriate, hereby makes the following Direction:

Citation and commencement

1. This Direction may be cited as the Fife Local Government Area (Electoral Arrangements) Direction 1994 and shall come into force on 11th November 1994.

Interpretation

2. In this Direction—

“Dunfermline Report” means the report of the Local Government Boundary Commission for Scotland to the Secretary of State for Scotland on its second statutory review of electoral arrangements for Dunfermline District dated 14th February 1994(b);

“Kirkcaldy Report” means the report of the Local Government Boundary Commission for Scotland to the Secretary of State for Scotland on its second statutory review of electoral arrangements for Kirkcaldy District dated 10th January 1994;

“North East Fife Report” means the report of the Local Government Boundary Commission for Scotland to the Secretary of State for Scotland on its second statutory

review of electoral arrangements for North East Fife District dated 14th September 1993.

Specification of Wards

3.— (1) For the purpose of any election of councillors held before the relevant year of election, the Fife local government area shall be divided into 92 electoral wards being—

- (a) the 34 proposed wards described in the Dunfermline Report;
- (b) the 40 proposed wards described (subject to the amendments set out in subparagraph (2) below) in the Kirkcaldy Report with those electoral wards being numbered wards 35 to 74 respectively in place of the numbering of the proposed wards in the Kirkcaldy Report; and
- (c) the 18 proposed wards described in the North East Fife Report with those electoral wards being numbered wards 75 to 92 respectively in place of the numbering of the proposed wards in the North East Fife Report.

(2) For the purposes of this Direction, the description of wards referred in the Kirkcaldy Report is amended as follows:—

- (a) in district ward 14 (Smeaton/Overton) for the word “eastward” where it secondly occurs, substitute the word “westward”; and

- (b) in district ward 15 (Sinclairtown/Gallatown) delete the words "the intersection of the said railway and".
