

The City of Glasgow Local Government Area (Electoral Arrangements) Direction 1994

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by paragraph 1(1) of Schedule 2 to the Local Government etc. (Scotland) Act 1994(a) and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and after carrying out such consultation as he considers appropriate, hereby makes the following Direction:

Citation and commencement

1. This Direction may be cited as the City of Glasgow Local Government Area (Electoral Arrangements) Direction 1994 and shall come into force on 11th November 1994.

Interpretation

2. In this Direction "polling district" means a polling district for Strathclyde Regional Council elections as at 3rd November 1994.

Specification of Wards

3. For the purpose of any election of councillors held before the relevant year of election the City of Glasgow local government area shall be divided into 83 electoral wards being—

- (a) the eighty one proposed wards numbered district ward 1 (Drumry) to district ward 78 (Aikenhead) and district wards 82 (Carmunnock) to district ward 84 (Glenwood) described in the report of the Local Government Boundary Commission for Scotland to the Secretary of State for Scotland on its second statutory review of electoral arrangements for the City of Glasgow District

dated 8th September 1994(a), with those electoral wards being numbered wards 1 to 81 respectively in place of the numbering of proposed wards in the said Report; and

(b) the following electoral wards:—

Electoral Ward 82: Toryglen

Polling districts RU 01 and RU 02.

Electoral Ward 83: King's Park

Polling district CC 23.
