

The Perthshire and Kinross Local Government Area (Electoral Arrangements) Direction 1994

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by paragraph 1(1) of Schedule 2 to the Local Government etc. (Scotland) Act 1994(a) and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and after carrying out such consultation as he considers appropriate, hereby makes the following Direction:

Citation and commencement

1. This Direction may be cited as the Perthshire and Kinross Local Government Area (Electoral Arrangements) Direction 1994 and shall come into force on 11th November 1994.

Interpretation

2. In this Direction, "polling district" means a polling district for Tayside Regional Council elections as at 1st December 1993.

Specification of Wards

3. For the purpose of any election of councillors held before the relevant year of election, the Perthshire and Kinross local government area shall be divided into 32 electoral wards being—

- (a) the 31 proposed wards described (subject to the amendments of the descriptions of wards set out for the purposes of this Direction in the Schedule to this Direction) in the report of the Local Government Boundary Commission for Scotland to the Secretary of State for Scotland on its second statutory review

of electoral arrangements for Perth and Kinross District dated 16th March 1994(a); and

(b) the following electoral ward:-

Electoral Ward 32: Invergowrie/Longforgan

That area comprising polling district PDB and those parts of polling district PDA which fall within the Perthshire and Kinross local government area.

Paragraph 3

1. In District Ward 17 (Crieff East), for the word "southwestward" where it first occurs, substitute the word "southeastward";
2. In District Ward 20 (Rannoch and Atholl), after the word "three", insert the words "burns"; and
3. In District Ward 28 (Dunsinane/St Martins), for the word "Fiarion", substitute the word "Friarton".
